

Uyghur Forced Labour Prevention Act LMI Technologies Statement

The U.S. Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act (Public Law No. 117-78), also known as the UFLPA, was enacted on December 23, 2021, with a June 21, 2022 effective date .

The purpose of this law is to ensure that goods made with forced labor in the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region of the People's Republic of China do not enter the United States market

LMI Technologies fully supports the objectives of Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act and considers this as our social responsibility to respect human rights and does not accept any form of human trafficking or forced labor in the supply chain.

LMI technologies will maintain communications with our suppliers and perform due diligence within their supply chains through the supplier self-assessment questionnaire to give us a better understanding of how our supplier manages human rights including labor rights,forced labor and anti-corruption principles
