

REACH Certificate of compliance

REGULATION (EC) No 1907/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) requires that all chemical substances used on Products distributed within the European Union either on their own, in preparations or those which are intentionally released from Products be registered with the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).

The regulations apply to substances manufactured within, or imported into, the European Union in annual quantities of one tonne or more unless the regulation indicates otherwise. In addition, REACH requires that any chemical containing a Substance of Very High Concern ("SVHC") be identified as being contained within a Product.

Based on information obtained from our suppliers, this document certifies that none of the LMI technologies product contains > 0.1% by weight of the Substances of the Very High Concern (SVHC), candidate list released on February 2026 (253 substances), with the exception of Lead and Cadmium, which is contained in some products/electronic components via RoHS exemptions

All information provided in this Certificate of Compliance is accurate, to the best of our knowledge. For this letter LMI Technologies completely relies upon the supplier provided information, however LMI have taken all reasonable steps to verify the supply line information regarding the absence of the restricted substances.
